INTRODUCTION:

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Shane Davis commented we will have the one-cent sales tax on the ballot on December 5, 2020. He explained that this not a new tax. In essence just the verbiage has been changed to use this money for any lawful purpose in the Village. There were lengthy discussions on this issue from residents throughout the town that were in attendance at the meeting.

Quannah Hatten commented that she is still working on prices for all street signs and also speed bumps.

NEW BUSINESS:


Mayor Davis commented we will be submitting prices to Fema on damages that have not been covered by insurance. Mayor commented that the cost of damages comes to a total of approximately \$28,000.00.

Bill Dean with Pan-American commented he has no business for the Village this month.


Mayor Davis commented that our contract with AT&T on internet service had expired that we will need to change to another entity. Mayor Davis gave the council three quotes with Unity being the cheapest. Alderman Daryl Bryant made a motion that we use Unity for our internet service. 2nd by Elisa Holton.

Mayor Davis commented that tomorrow is Veteran's Day and would like to salute all Veteran's for their service. Those that were in attendance were Donald Smith-Army, Joy Hicks-Army, Buck Spillman-Marines and also Victor Locker-Army.
