**INTRODUCTION:**

Mayor Shane Davis called the meeting of the Village of Dry Prong to order. Invocation was led by Mark Barbee. Alderman Della Barbee, Elisa Holton and Daryl Bryant was present. Chief Spillman led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Donald Smith and Zac Daenan were present at the meeting. Bill Dean with Pan-American Engineers was also present.

**COMMENTS FROM THE FLOOR:**

There were no comments from the floor at this time.

Quanah Hatten commented there are street lights within the Village and all have been reported. Chief Spillman commented there have been speed limits posted around town hoping everyone will observe the traffic laws.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Mayor Shane Davis commented that in Hillview Subdivision there are washouts on the side of the roads. For safety reasons these need our attention. The Village is waiting on legal answers at the time before we can fix these issues. We will need to put up cones on the washout along this road.

The Village will be doing the traditional trick or treating this year which will be door to door. We are asking patrons to leave their light on if they will be participating in this.

The Village will not have parade this year due to hurricane damage and also the pandemic but we will have tree lighting ceremony on December 12, 2020 at 4 p.m. in front of town hall. We are asking children to bring ornaments to decorate the tree.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Mayor Davis commented our insurance has paid for the buildings that were damaged by the hurricane. All things that were damaged were not covered. Bernard Insurance was present at the meeting and commented he would be glad to give us coverage on lift stations, ground storage building and also fencing. We would have to be specific in naming the other entities that need to be covered and he will work on giving a quote.


Bill Dean with Pan-American gave us a quote on the materials for the roads in Hillview Subdivision. This is a quote on materials and this does not include labor. Mayor Davis commented that we will be looking into this issue in the future.

Quanah Hatten Maintenance Supervisor gave us a quote for all new signs within the Village. Mayor and council discussed putting in speed bumps on First Street, Grove Street, and Second Street. Mayor Davis asked Ms. Hatten to get quotes on these also. This will be discussed further in the next month meeting.

Mayor Davis commented he had checked on equipment for putting all our ordinances in program that can be easily accessed. We will discuss this more in the future.
