INTRODUCTION:

Mayor Shane Davis called the meeting of the Village of Dry Prong to order. Invocation was led by Shane Davis. Alderman Elisa Holton and Daryl Bryant were present. Della Barbee was absent due to family medical reasons. Chief Spillman led the Pledge of Allegiance. Bill Dean with Pan-American Engineers was also present.

COMMENTS FROM THE FLOOR:

Buddy Pennison who is working with the Village gave reports on projects that he has been working on throughout the Village.

Alderman Elisa Holton made a motion to approve the March minutes. 2nd by Daryl Bryant.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Shane Davis commented that we will be receiving a payment from Fema on project 1 that have been fixed in the village from Hurricane Laura. We are still working on the 2nd project from Fema that have not been fixed.

Chris Wiley brought a Zoning Ordinance booklet that we will be moving forward with on blighted properties. Alderman Daryl Bryant made a motion to move forward on this issue. 2nd by Elisa Holton.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Davis commented that the Sheriff's Office will be receiving 879 K dollars from Fema to spend on Generators throughout the Parish. This is a project that we can apply for in the Village of Dry Prong, we will have to pay for every generator we apply for up front and Fema will reimburse the Village 75%. This is due by May 1, 2021.

Mayor Davis that the Village of Dry Prong will be awarded \$161,502.02 through the Cares Act to spend money on water, sewer, broadband, education. He commented he is not for certain when these monies will be available. This will be through a Grant.

Alderman Daryl Bryant made a motion to pass the Resolution on the Municipal Water Prevention Pollution prevention for January 2020-December 2020. 2nd by Elisa Holton.

Bill Dean with Pan-American presented with information on street drainage on Kisatchie, First, and Second Street. The roads are being washed out and ditches are being washed away. This project will cost approximately \$90,000.00 Alderman Daryl Bryant made a motion that use the money that is the street funds to move forward on this project. 2nd by Elisa Holton.

Mayor Davis made a motion that we move into Executive Session to discuss personnel issues.

Alderman Elisa Holton made a motion to adjourn. 2nd by Daryl Bryant.
