**COMMENTS FROM THE FLOOR:**

Alderman Elisa Holton made a motion to approve the May minutes. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Della Barbee.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Brennan Gaspard with Pan-American presented a Resolution to submit a FY application for funding under the LCDBG Program for Sewer Rehabilitation. Alderman Della Barbee made a motion to accept this Resolution. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Elisa Holton.

Alderman Della Barbee made a motion to adopt Ordinance 4-21 the Comprehensive Building Regulations for the Village of Dry Prong relative to construction codes and to provide for related matters. 2<sup>nd</sup> By Elisa Holton. Added to this Ordinance is 5-21 Defining Nuisances and Offensive conditions, providing for the Disposition of Nuisance Situations, and Providing Penalties for the Violations of this Ordinance. Motion made by Elisa Holton. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Della Barbee.

Alderman Della Barbee made a motion to adopt Ordinance 6-21 to assess a collection Fee on Debts referred to a collection agency. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Elisa Holton.

Bill Dean with Pan-American Engineers commented that he will presenting a bid document on the drainage project for Kisatchie and First Streets.

**New Business:**

Attorney Bonita Armour presented a Resolution for Moving Ahead Progress in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Transportation Act provides funds to the State of Louisiana for grants to federal, state, local government agencies, non-profit organizations and commercial entities to acquire, develop and/or maintain motorized and non-motorized trails; the Village of Dry Prong does hereby endorse and support the application being submitted to the FRTPL by the B-22 Sports Complex, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project. Motion made by Elisa Holton. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Della Barbee.

Alderman Della Barbee made a motion to adopt Ordinance 2-21 adopting the budget of revenues and expenditures for the General Fund budget FY 21/22 to be in compliance. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Elisa Holton.

Alderman Della Barbee made a motion to adopt Ordinance 3-21 adopting compensation for the Clerk of the Village of Dry Prong. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Elisa Holton.
